Wildland Community Preparedness Day

Travis AFB FD

Travis AFB FD will be conducting training burns on May 6-7-8, on a Monday-Tuesday-Wednesday schedule from 0900 to 1200hrs. We have been invited to participate with a crew and an engine on any of the days. Crews wanting to go will need to meet out at the Travis FD Training Grounds on Perimeter Road each of the days before 0900hrs. This is an opportunity to do some live-fire training. WEBSITE

The Vacaville Fire Protection District Website, <u>vfpd.net</u>, is being updated regularly. There are links to video's, photos, public information, and dates to remember.

Applications for Volunteer Firefighter are now available through the website only. Spread the word if you know someone interested in volunteering.

Navigating the Website:

Step 1) Look for your search bar on the internet.

Step 2) Type vfpd.net into the search bar and hit Enter

Step 3) Scroll up or down to find a category of interest.

Step 4) Put your mouse or curser over that category and press enter.

That subject will then be displayed.



- Securing stations/vehicle before leaving for the night, all doors are to be locked and all vehicles shall be properly secured.
- The District Equipment storage area is provided for your gear and only the assigned member should be in the assigned area. Do not borrow any equipment from the assigned storage area.
- Fuel (top off), clean, and lock up units upon returning to stations after meetings, incidents, Duty Officer Assignment, etc. Take time to fill out the gas log neatly and completely.
- Station cleaning it shall be the responsibility of all members to assist in keeping their assigned station clean.
- Ensure ALL personnel are using Active 911
- Fire Reports: Always assign someone as the "Reporting Officer." All reports must be completed in ESO and turned in by noon the day after the incident. If the incident is cancelled, a report must still be submitted. Please do not put any times on the Incident Report, those are put in by administration.

"New Recruit Binders" should be checked off and signed. Make sure to get them turned in within the allotted time frame. This is a requirement. See your FTO with any questions.
